### The Position:

MAG is seeking a qualified transportation engineer to support its efforts in the Transportation Policy and Planning Division. The position will focus on activities related to the management and implementation of the Freeway Life Cycle Program, Arterial Life Cycle Program, and Regional Transportation Plan (RTP). Duties include managing transportation studies; assessing, analyzing and evaluating transportation infrastructure design, functionality, cost, schedule, and project risk; developing alternative approaches to respond to mobility needs and traffic demand; and coordination with stakeholders and partners, including member agencies and the Arizona Department of Transportation, to support policy and implementation efforts. The position will also include facilitation of working group sessions and public meeting presentations.

### The Candidate:

The ideal candidate will be an experienced engineer in the area of highway/roadway design/planning or traffic operations. The candidate will be proficient in leading planning-level analysis and reviewing engineering and design-specific solutions. The candidate should have experience working with consultants or consultant teams, preferably in a large urban area.

Experience coordinating with agency partners and stakeholders is preferred. Experience presenting complex technical information to a diverse set of stakeholders, including members of the public and policy makers, highly desired.

### Experience and Education

A Bachelor's degree in civil engineering or related field with a minimum of at least four (4) years of experience in freeway and roadway design, planning, or traffic engineering required. Private sector and project management experience a plus. Professional Engineer (PE) license desired but not required.
